**Agenda Items Eligible for Membership & Board of Directors Consideration:**

6. Two requests regarding AQHA's recording and/or dissemination of five panel test results:
  - (a) Display five panel test results on the front—as opposed to the back-of the registration certificate to increase public awareness (member)
  - (b) Discontinue any dissemination of five panel test results to non-owners and create AQHA Ethical Practices Review Board to address breeder “dishonesty” and “ethical and morality issues.” (member)
7. Two requests regarding REG106.1 (Horses Not Eligible For Registration):
  - (a) Amend REG106.1 to state: Offspring resulting from an appendix registered sire or dam bred to another appendix registered horse in **which the resulting foal carries more than 50% Thoroughbred blood.** (member)
  - (b) Amend REG106.1 to state: Offspring resulting from an appendix registered sire or dam bred to another appendix registered horse in **which the resulting foal carries more than 37.5% Thoroughbred blood.** (member)
8. Two requests regarding REG104.2 (Obtaining A Numbered Registration Certificate):
  - (a) Delete “**or excessive white markings**” to make excessive white markings acceptable to advance from Appendix. (member) The rule currently states:

“Horses having parrot mouth, cryptorchidism, HYPP **or excessive white markings** are not eligible for advancement.”

- (b) Remove the following: **“not restricted in any way (youth and/or amateur Register of Merit do not qualify a horse for advancement)”**. (member) The rule currently states:

“Except as otherwise limited on proper compliance with the rules and regulations of AQHA, a stallion, mare, gelding or spayed mare may be registered in the Numbered section of the Stud Book that...previously has been listed in the Appendix, and the following conditions are met: (1) the horse has qualified for Register of Merit in AQHA-approved events **not restricted in any way (youth and/or amateur Register of Merit do not qualify a horse for advancement)**...

9. Amend REG127.2 (Death Of A Horse) by changing reference to **“25 years”** to **“30 years”**. (member) The rule currently states:

When AQHA records indicate a horse has lived **25 years** past January 1 of its foaling year, it will be automatically presumed to no longer be alive and automatically removed from the inventory of living horses.

10. Amend REG102.7 (Transfer Report) to reflect that no transfer fee shall be charged if AQHA receives a registration application and transfer report for a horse at same time. Transfer fees shall be assessed for subsequent changes of ownership. (member)
11. Amend REG102.8 (Parentage Verification) to require that **“Any and all foals must be parentage verified in order to be registered.”** (member)
12. To become effective after the 2017 breeding season, amend REG108 and REG124.2 to reflect that a mare or stallion may not be transferred without DNA testing and results shown on all current papers. (member)
13. Discuss phase in period to require microchipping on all registrations. (member)
